Leadership Spotlight

Leadership has always been a complicated idea for me. It's not something one can easily and clearly define. But what I've learned from my previous roles is that leadership involves taking a step back, seeing the bigger picture, and setting the direction for your team.

My journey from the Congressional District Office to the City Information Office of Iligan City revealed these profound truths. From stepping up unexpectedly to embracing a people-first approach and realizing the importance of alignment with organizational values, these experiences have shaped my understanding of effective leadership.

The Art of Decision-Making

One of the most striking realizations I had was that leadership is more about making key decisions than executing tasks. My ascent to a leadership role came unexpectedly when the head of our department had to leave abruptly due to a family emergency. With no preparation or succession plan in place, our team had to quickly choose a new leader, and my colleagues believed I was the right person for the job.

Initially, I continued in my role as a writer, under the impression that leadership was just a title and that my duties wouldn't change much. However, within weeks, it became clear that I needed to shift my focus. Leadership required me to see the bigger picture, to ensure our team was aligned and progressing toward our goals. I had to step back from my writing tasks and delegate them to others, which meant advocating for additional help. This transition taught me that effective leaders prioritize strategic decisions and delegation over getting bogged down in specific tasks.

Prioritizing People Over Tasks

Another crucial insight was understanding that the success of a team hinges on the well-being of its members. Early on, I often found myself prioritizing work over the needs of my team. The result? Missed deadlines, reduced work quality, and a general sense of dissatisfaction. I soon realized that when I focused on ensuring my team was supported and had the resources they needed, our performance improved dramatically.

This principle of people-first leadership became my guiding philosophy. When team members feel valued and supported, they are more motivated and productive. Creating a positive, nurturing environment is essential for any team to thrive.

Finding the Right Fit

Lastly, I learned that not every organization is a perfect fit for every leader or team. In my previous role, I believed I could change the existing culture and system to better suit my vision. However, I faced resistance at

every turn. The entrenched cultural and political dynamics were too strong to overcome, and the necessary changes were not forthcoming.

Recognizing that the environment was becoming toxic and unbearable, I made the difficult decision to leave. This experience underscored the importance of aligning with an organization whose values and work culture resonate with your own. It's crucial to find a workplace where you and your team can thrive, rather than constantly battling against an incompatible system.

In my quest for a new beginning, I found Best Seller Publishing (BSP). Although my role here is different and the setup is remote since I'm working from home, I can tell the environment is so much better. At BSP, leaders genuinely care about their people, treating us not just as resources but as valued individuals.

It's easy to overlook employees in a remote work setup, but our leaders go out of their way to ensure we connect every week through our Monday and Friday meetings. The leaders ask about our personal lives and how we are outside work. Although we respect the hierarchy, I don't think anyone has ever felt like they are at the bottom or lower end of the organizational chart. This supportive culture has reaffirmed my belief in the power of a positive work environment.

Conclusion

While leadership remains a complex concept, one truth stands clear to me — true leaders genuinely care about their people. They prioritize their team's best interests and seek opportunities to connect on a deeper level.

Someday, when I become a leader of a group, I know what my top priority will be. I won't aim for the biggest building, the highest profits, or the most popular name. Instead, I will strive to create an organization where members are well taken care of and love working for me and with me.
